Here at Lanes Vets, we offer a wide array of nurse clinics, including:

After 8 clinics 🐱 🐶

For your golden oldies over 8 years old, you will get 10% off general blood tests and a urine test. We will also discuss any issues that usually come along with older age and how to manage/prevent them.

Weight clinic ⚖️

For any animals struggling with weight, we will give you a diet plan, food vouchers, 10% off a weight loss diet purchased from us, and a diary to make sure your pet has the best chance of getting to the weight they need to be to keep them happy and healthy.

Dental Clinic 🦷

We will do a full dental check and grade the teeth for any pet, but especially pets with smelly breath or bad teeth. We will give you advice on how to prevent or improve your pet's teeth or refer them to a vet for further treatment if needed.
